Education — BSPS

155+ children (60% girls) at our own school in Hathikhera, Ajmer — playgroup to grade 8, est. 2013.



Health — Taiyari

20,000+ adolescents reached across 30 Gram Panchayats with health education and life skills.



HIV Prevention — TI

700 high-risk individuals covered in Ajmer with RSACS — counselling, screening, harm reduction.



Aarogyam Kendra

Community health centre in Ajmer district — primary care, maternal health, immunisation. Built with CSR.

Education – Clause (ii)

BSPS provides quality education to 155+ children (60% girls). SEDI trained 300+ women and youth in vocational skills over 11 years.

Healthcare – Clause (i)

Taiyari reaches 20,000+ across 30 Gram Panchayats. TI programme covers 700 high-risk individuals with RSACS. Aarogyam Kendra community health centre inaugurated January 2026 with CSR funding.

Women Empowerment – Clause (iii)

Self-help groups, vocational training, and financial literacy. Babli Boli radio programme reached 14,670+ rural women through 100 Listeners' Clubs.

Rural Development – Clause (x)

Community development across 30+ Gram Panchayats in Jaipur, Ajmer, and Tonk – capacity building, networking, and advocacy.

Case study — Aarogyam Kendra with Cochin Shipyard Ltd

The Gap

Rural communities in Ajmer district lacked access to primary healthcare — women and children travelled 15+ km for basic services.

The Partnership

BSS partnered with Cochin Shipyard Ltd (₹40 lakh CSR) to build Aarogyam Kendra — a community health centre for primary care, maternal health, immunisation, and health education.

The Outcome

Inaugurated January 2026 — now serving rural communities in Ajmer district with primary care, maternal health, and immunisation.

The Gap

2,000 adolescents across 10 government schools in Jaipur had no access to health education or life-skills training.

The Work

Structured ARSH health-education sessions delivered in all 10 schools over 15 months.

The Outcome

2,000 adolescents educated on reproductive health, nutrition, and life skills; teachers trained as ongoing resource persons.

SEDI Skills Centre

with NSDC / RKCL

The Gap

Rural women and youth in Ajmer had limited access to vocational training or employment-ready certifications.

The Work

BSS operated the SEDI centre offering RS-CIT, RS-CFA, sewing, and photography courses – RKCL-approved certifications.

The Outcome

300+ graduates with employable certifications over 11 years; many now self-employed or working in local businesses.
